## NTL ELECTRICAL SERVICES LTD TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE

- General

All services and goods supplied by us are sold only upon the following conditions. The placing of an order for any services/goods, or the acceptance of our quotation or tender includes acceptance of the following conditions. Our record of any order placed by you verbally shall be conclusive as to the type and quantity of product and the point and date of deliver.

- Connections to the mains will be made when all conditions of the following terms and conditions of sale are fulfilled.
- If by reason of labour difficulties or shortage of materials or any cause outside the control of NTL Electrical Services Ltd, or NTL Electrical Services Ltd is unable to provide all or any of the services ordered by the customer during the whole or part of the duration of the exhibition, the customer's rights shall be limited to the return of a corresponding proportion of the charge paid by the customer for such services.
- NTL Electrical Services Ltd, its employees or agents, will not be liable for damage to property or injury to persons by or in any way connected with the services provided, except only where such damage or injury is occasioned by the negligence of NTL Electrical Services Ltd, its employees or its agents..
- On no account will NTL Electrical Services Ltd be liable for any direct or indirect consequential loss suffered by the customer howsoever caused.

### ON HIRE ELECTRICAL SUPPLIES INCLUDING CONNECTIONS AND ENERGY CHARGES

1. The nominal power supply voltage is 230 volts for single phase equipment, and 400 volts for three phase equipment at 50Hz.
2. The charges detailed on the price list include: for the on hire supply and installation from the electricity supply source, a proportion of the necessary mains cable, power outlet and circuit protection, and for dismantling / removing all plant and materials at the event closure.
3. The electricity supply will be terminated at the nearest point on the exhibitors stand in relation to the electricity supply source. Exhibitors requiring a different termination point should provide details on a separate sheet of paper and attach it to the electrical order form.
4. It is strictly understood that only ONE item of electrical equipment is connected to each power point ordered and the wattage of the said electrical equipment is equal to or less than the maximum wattage size of the supply requested.
5. Exhibitors using pre-wired or mobile stands, including caravans, must take into account the full load of appliances. On no account must the connected load exceed the size of the supply requested. All mobile units must arrive on site fitted with a 30ma RCD trip switch and carry a current electrical test certificate.
6. Any exhibitor found making unauthorised connections to the electrical network or multiple connections from one stand to another will be immediately cut off from the supply and service denied to them.
7. All exhibitors will be held responsible for any materials, etc, which are damaged or missing at the end of the show. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that equipment is returned in good order.
8. Applications for the electricity supply must be received by us no later than the deadline date on the order form. After which no guarantee will be given that the work will be carried out. Although it may be possible to carry out additional orders the price will be subject to a 25% surcharge.
9. Complaints with regard to our services must be submitted in writing if possible before the event closure. This will ensure that the complaint is fully investigated.
10. We reserve the right to refuse to connect to the supply any faulty exhibitor appliances.
11. The use of personal generating sets is strictly prohibited other than for the purpose of demonstration.
12. We shall not be held responsible for the loss of power due to faulty appliances tripping our circuit protection.
13. Supply of electricity should normally be available to most stands from 5.00pm on the day prior to the show commencing, until the official closure of the show. However, should this not be possible for whatever reason NTL Electrical Services Ltd cannot be held responsible and will not accept any claims for loss of earnings or otherwise.
14. Refunds for cancellations will only be given if notice of cancellation is received by NTL Electrical Services Ltd, in writing, prior to the deadline date stated on the order form. Where written cancellation is received later than this date the services ordered will be charged at the full rate as the work is prepared in advance.
15. Any portable electrical appliance over 12 months old, intended for use at this event must display a valid PAT tested certificate, otherwise power will not be connected.
16. We reserve the right to disconnect and remove to the organiser's office any appliance, which is faulty and without a current PAT Certificate.
17. No work will be carried out until payment without retention has been received by NTL Electrical Services Ltd.
